"septic technique aims to prevent pathogenic organisms, in sufficient quantity to cause infection, from being introduced to susceptible sites by hands, surfaces and equipment. Approximately 200,000 healthcare-associated infections (HAIs) occur in Australia each year, making them the most common complication affecting patients in hospital. Aseptic technique is an important clinical practice that reduces the risk of patients acquiring an infection during clinical procedures. The Australasian College for Infection Prevention and Control has guidelines which form the basis for this session.
