REFLECTION:

Epidemic thunderstorm asthma' is an unusual cluster of allergic asthma flare-ups (including severe acute asthma) associated with some types of thunderstorms in spring or early summer. Epidemics can occur when such a storm travels across a region and triggers asthma in many susceptible individuals, causing a high demand on ambulance and health services. This session explores this condition and utilises the resources of National Asthma Council of Australia as the basis.
