#### REFLECTION:

Furunculosis is a deep infection of the hair follicle leading to abscess formation with an accumulation of pus and necrotic tissue. Furuncles appear as red, swollen, and tender nodules on hair-bearing parts of the body, and the most common infectious agent is *Staphylococcus aureus*. This session explores the aetiology, treatment and suggested preventative strategies.
