REFLECTION:

In 2015 the Australian Guidelines for the Prevention and Control of Infections in Healthcare remains the key reference source for Healthcare settings and identifies that 'Transmission-based precautions are used in addition to Standard Precautions, where the suspected or confirmed presence of infectious agents represents an increased risk of transmission. The application of transmission-based precautions is particularly important in containing multi-resistant organisms (MROs) and in outbreak management.

Medical and dental procedures increase the risk of transmission of infectious agents. Effective work practices to minimise the risk of transmission of infection related to procedures require consideration of the specific situation, as well as appropriate use of standard and transmission-based precautions.
