REFLECTION:

Thyroid dysfunction in pregnancy has consequences for mother and baby. Potential problems include pre-eclampsia, prematurity and congenital abnormality. Thyroid dysfunction affects 2-3% of pregnant women and one in 10 women of childbearing age with normal thyroid function have underlying thyroid autoimmunity, which may indicate reduced functional reserve. Up to 18% of women in the first trimester in Australia are thyroid antibody positive. This session explores the physiology and management of pregnant women with thyroid disorders.
