REFLECTION:

Ovarian hyperstimulation syndrome (OHSS) is a serious iatrogenic condition, predominantly related to the hormone used to induce oocyte maturation during IVF treatment. OHSS is characterised by ovarian enlargement, ascites, pleural effusion, oliguria, haemoconcentration and thromboembolic events.' This session explores the clinical parameters of ovarian hyperstimulation syndrome following different hormonal triggers of oocyte maturation in IVF treatment.
