REFLECTION:

Human papillomaviruses (HPVs) are small, non-enveloped viruses with circular double-stranded DNA. HPVs infect and replicate primarily within cutaneous and mucosal epithelial tissues. Infection with HPV is very common in both men and women, with initial infection occurring close to the time of sexual debut. It is estimated that up to 79% of the general population will be infected with at least one genital type of HPV at some time in their lives.
