REFLECTION:

The Zika virus is primarily transmitted through the bite of infected Aedes species mosquitoes. The Centre for Disease Control (CDC) has confirmed that the Zika virus can also be sexually transmitted from a man infected with the virus to his sexual partners. Most persons infected with Zika virus are asymptomatic. Signs and symptoms, when present, are typically mild, with the most common being acute onset of fever, macular or papular rash, arthralgia, and conjunctivitis.
